**Soccer: One (1) year Pilot Rule Modification for the 2012 Season**

Rule – 12, section 8, article 3(d) 2 which reads:

A player shall be disqualified (red card) for: A foul by a player against an opponent who is moving toward his/her offensive goal with an obvious opportunity to score.

2012 Modification – A player sent off for violation of Rule 12:8 article 3(d)2

A player committing a deliberate tactical foul in a non-flagrant manner against an opponent who is moving toward his/her offensive goal with an obvious opportunity to score shall not suffer the two (2) game disqualification. The team must play short one (1) person for the rest of the game. The official issuing the send-off shall indicate this by displaying the red card in one hand and the yellow card in the other.

*\* A deliberate foul is defined as:*

*A purposely planned act done to disrupt the game and to gain an advantage through the unfair act.*
